- Greece has 6000 islands but only 264 are inhabited.

continent	Any of the world's main expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica)
climate	A weather pattern in a region.
population	All the people who live in a place.
tourist	A tourist is a person who is visiting a place for pleasure and interest.
Equator	The Equator is an imaginary line around the middle of the Earth.
Northern hemisphere	The Northern Hemisphere is the half of Earth that is north of the Equator.
Tropic of cancer	An imaginary line, north of the equator that runs around the Earth.
Physical feature	Natural features on the Earth's surface. E.g., mountain, river
Human feature	Built by people. E.g., house, church

- Greece has a warm, climate and enjoys more than 250 days of sunshine a year.
- 30 million tourists visited Greece in 2022.
