












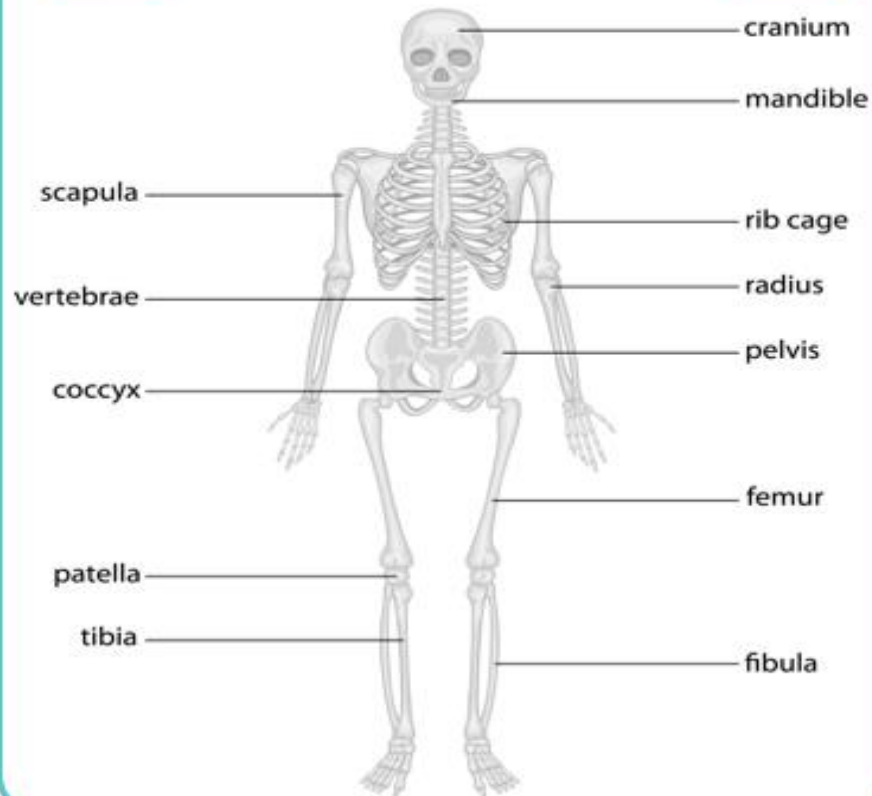
	vitamin	found in foods for the body's growth, repair and building immunity.

	radius	one of the bones found in the lower arm
	tibia	one of the bones found in the lower leg
	rib cage	protects the heart and lungs
	spine	the structure of bones that runs up the centre of the back
	hamstrings	muscles that run down the back of the leg
	biceps	muscles found in the upper arm
